Conditional Offer Holder - Grades Met

You are holding a conditional firm or insurance place and your place has been marked as confirmed on UCAS Track

- Congratulations - If your place is confirmed, your place is now secure. Check your emails for information from the university.

Unconditional Offer Holder

You are holding an unconditional place as your firm choice and this has been marked as confirmed on UCAS track

- Congratulations - If your firm choice is unconditional then your place is secure. Check your emails for information from the university.

Missed Grades - Place Confirmed or Awaiting Decision

You have not gained the entry requirements but you have not been released into Clearing

- Place confirmed - Universities may still award the place, check UCAS Track to see if your Firm or Insurance choice is marked as confirmed.
- Alternative Offer - The University may make you an alternative offer which you can accept or decline on UCAS Track.
- Awaiting Decision - The University may still be considering whether to award you a place. Contact them to see if there is anything they need from you. You can self-release into Clearing.

Missed Grades - Place Unsuccessful

Your grades were not high enough for your place to be confirmed and your choices have been marked as unsuccessful on UCAS Track.

- University Appeal - The University may consider you for an alternative course e.g. Foundation degree. Contact them to find out.
- Re-takes - You can re-take exams in summer 2021 and reapply through the next UCAS cycle.
- Clearing - If you still want to go to university you may be able to find an alternative university place. Check out the UCAS Guide on Clearing.
- Decisions on the appeals process are yet to be taken. Check the Qualifications Wales website for updates.

Exceeded Predicted Grades

Your grades are higher than those originally predicted on your UCAS application

- Adjustment - You can apply to universities with higher entry requirements than your previous predictions whilst still holding your original place for five days following results day. See UCAS guidance on Adjustment.

Change of Mind?

- You no longer want to go to university in this cycle? Contact the university from which you have a confirmed place without delay and withdraw your place. NB: This cannot be undone.
- Want to change university? Discouraged at this late stage, but if you are sure you want to apply to other universities then you can self-release into Clearing from July 5th onwards. NB: This cannot be undone.
- Want to change course? If you want to go to the same university but change to a different course, you must contact the university to discuss this.
