### Definition of a Service child:

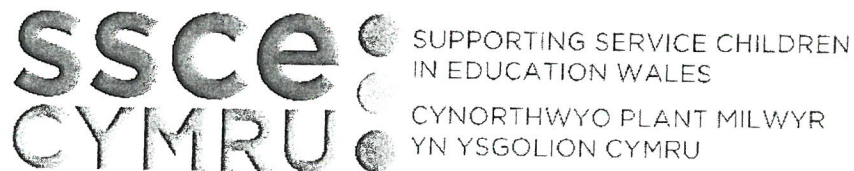
A child whose parent/s are currently serving or have served in the past six years in the Army, Navy, RAF or as a Reservist.
